



CONNECT RESEARCH/CREATIVITY GRANT GUIDELINES

The purpose of the CONNECT Grant program is to provide funding support for undergraduate students who want to take their education to the next level, to do something beyond standard course work that is different, out-of-the-box and exceptional. The library is anxious to support students who are being held back from taking the next step in their university education due to a lack of funding. CONNECT Grants provide awards up to \$1000, on a competitive basis to help make these types of projects possible.

SUBMISSIONS: Grant proposals may only be submitted through the CONNECT Online Proposal Forms. All potential grantees should read and follow all of the grant guidelines and comply with grant deadlines. Expedited reviews may be requested for unusual or emergency situations. Deadlines -- *Fall Semester* - 2nd Friday in October, 2nd Friday in November
Spring Semester - 2nd Friday in February, 2nd Friday in March
Summer Semester – 2nd Friday in June
