 - i. A University email shall not be used to send an email for Political Objectives for a Political Activity or other political purpose;
 - ii. to advocate for or against a proposed initiative, initiative, proposed referendum, referendum, a proposed bond, a bond, or any ballot proposition; or
 - iii. to solicit a campaign contribution;
 - iv. except:
 - A. to provide information solely to another person or a group of people in response to a question asked by the other person or group of people; or
 - B. for an internal communication solely wM

- 3. Registered Political Parties may be charged for the cost of custodial services for cleaning the meeting facility after the use by the political party, and for any service requested by the political party and provided by the meeting facility as described in Utah Code §20A-8-404.
