## SUBJECT: AUX TARY ENTERPRISES

- PU OSE: To provide policy fir institutional operation of auxilial enterprises, identification of activities operated as auxilial enterprises, and reporting and accountability requirements fir such auxilial enterprises.
- II. DEFINITION: Auxilia Enterprises are business enterprises or other support activities (as distinguished from primal programs of instruction, research, and public service) operated on an essentially self-supporting basis, the primary purpose of which is to provide specified services to students, if culty, staffor guests of the institution.
- III. POLICY: To confirm with State Board of Regents policies R550 and R555.

  A uxilia enterprises are operated as essential elements in support of the education, research a dipublic service programs of the institutions. They are to be operated at a level of quality sufficient to support the objectives of the self-supporting basis wherever possible. Services provided by auxilia enterprises may be incidentally available to Center Smith Resident Living
- B. Charges: A ppropriate charges shall be made to users of the auxilia enterprises, including academic or administrative departments. To the extent reasonably possible, selling prices, rents, if es, admissions and other charges by each auxilia enterprise are to be set at a level adequate to support the operating and reserve requirements of the enterprise.
- C. Oversite by Board of Trustees: The Board of Trustees is responsible to review the auxiliaenterprises annual reports and firmonitoring both management of and quality of services provided by the auxiliaenterprises.
- D. Competition: Goods and services shall be provided in accordance with Board of Regents policy R555 to the campus community, may not be advertised to the general public, and may not be generally provided to persons who are not members of the campus community.
