SUBJECT: CONSTITUTION OF THE SOUTHERN UTAH UNIVERSITY STUDENT ASSOCIATION

SECTION 20: The Assembly shall be composed of two Delegates from each Cluband Organization category. The Assembly shall have no less than four categories.

SECTION 21: All Assembly Delegates must be active members of a chartered clubor organization within the category they represent upon election or appointment. The elegates of each category cannot be members of the same club or organization.

SECTION 22: The Assembly shallect a President Pro Tem and shall provide otherofficers from this body as are deemed necessary. President Pro Tem shall assume Presidency of the Assembly in the absence of the C&O President.

SECTION 23. All bills presented to the Assembly mustsponsored by a Delegar of the Assembly. All bills must be circled and posted for eview by the Assembly and the membership of SUUSA at least one week pulper to a vote by the Assembly.

SECTION 24: All bills take effect when passed bmajority vote of a word of the Assembly, as defined in Section 17 of Article IV, and upon signature of the resident. If the President does not approve of action taken by the Assembly, the esident may return the bill to the Assembly with objection noted. If, after further consideration, the Assembly repasses the bill by a three with vote of a quorunit, shall then be enacted. Should the President not sign a bill, and not return it withinfive school days of receipt, the bill shall automatica take effect.

ARTICLE V Executive Branch

SECTION 1: The Executive Branch shall consist of the Executive Council and the Student Activities Board.

SECTION 2: The Executive Council shall consist of the foiling elected offices: The President, Academic Vice President, C&O Vice President, and Activities Vice President. These four will be voting members of this body. All actions taken by Encecutive Council must be upon the recommendation and approved the President A

SECTION 6: Duties of the Controller: The primary responsibility of the Controller shall be to manage the financial records of the SUUSA in accordance with generally ccepted standards and procedures of SUU, while representing the accounting arm SUUSA according to the direction of the President. During the period in offibe, Controller shall have the responsibility educating the SUUSA officers on the proper procedures in requisitioning and collecting SUUSA monies.

SECTION 7: Duties of the Executive Secretary: The primary duty of the ExecutiveSecretary shall be to keep and preserve accurate minutes of all Executive meetings. These minutes shall be open for inspection by any member of the SUUSA. The ecutive Secretary shall also transcribe correspondence, and carry out any asseignments delegated by the President.

SECTION 8: The Student Activities Book(STAB): The primary duty of STAB shall be to organize and carry social activities and any other activities deemerolecessary for the efficient operation of the SUUSA. Members of STAB shall in rway be limited to a fixed number of members. Members of the STAB shall have with entity to choose assistants and organize committees upon approval of the Activities Vice President, in accordance with Article V, Section 5.

SECTION 9: Succession: In case of a vacancy in the office of the President, the Academic Vice President shall become President. In case of a vacancy in the office the Academic Vice President, the President Pro Tem of the Senate shall become Academic Vice President, and shall appoint a new Senator. In case of a vaintainey office of the C&O Vice President, the President Pro Tem on the Assemblyshall become C&O Vice President and shall appoint a new Delegate. SECTION 10: Duties of the C&O Vice President: The primary duty of the C&O VicePresident shall be to preside over the Assembly. S/he

a special committee to investigate any club or gagazation in violation of bylaws, policies, orules. In case of temporary absence of the SUUSA President and the Academic Veresident, the C&O Vice President shall act as the SUUSA President. The Jubs and Organizations Vice President shall have the fluo wewer to fill vacancies in the Assembly through appointment. This/these appointment(s) must have the approval of threfourths of the Assembly and must have the approval of threfourths of the Senate Vacancies shall be filled within four weeks. The Clubs and Organizations Veresident, in consultation with the President, has the authority to appoint a secretary of the assembly.

ARTICLE VI Judicial Branch

SECTION 1. The Judicial power of the SUUSA, which includes the authority cossume Writs of Mandamus and Judicial Review, shall be restection a judicial Council writ may be issued after the Judicial Council arrives at a majority opinite termine by a simple majority. Failure upon the part of any SUUSA official governing body served with a writ to perform the specified duties enumerated inwitite within a reasonable time, or to cease performing some unauthorized act, will beconsidered groundfor impeachment charges.

SECTION 2: The Judicial Council shall consist of a Chief Justice and four AssociateJustices.

SECTION 3: The Chief Justice shall be appointed by the President subject to proval by a thretourths majority vote of the Setted And vacables shall be filled within four weeks.

keepinformed of the legal affairs of the SUUSA.
