SECTION 2 The purpose of Student Gover entinside SUUSA (See Ar findefinition) is to:

- A. Promote unity within SUUSA;
- B. Voice student concer s to SUU Administration;
- C. Review and make recommendations concer ing student fees,
- D. Support student involvement and activities;
 - E. Promote quality education in all aspects of student lif;
- F. Represent the student body in the decision-making and policy-dev as prescribed in University policy;
- G. Communicate with all its members; and,
- H. Provide leadership opportunities to its members.

ARTICLE I Membership

All matriculated fill- and part-time, undergraduate and graduate Souther students paying the fill corresponding fees shall be members of SUUSA. the Executive Council, the Presidential abinet, the Academic Senate, the Clubs and Student Leadership Council [CSL Council], the tudent Activities Board [STAB], and the Judicial Council. Collectively these groups are af rred to as "SUUSA Student Government" "throughout this document.

SECTION 2 In order to be eligible to apply for an appointed position, run f r an elected of ce, and/or hold and maintain any elected or appointed position or of ce within SUUSA Student Gover ent, an individual shall:
