SUBJECT: DEANS' COUNCIL

- I. PURPOSE: To coordinate and recommend all aspects of the academic budgets, calendar, class schedules, curriculum, planning, and other policies related to academic affairs
- II. POLICY:
  - A. The Council serves as the representative agency at the University level for specific policy matters relating to faculty concerns that are more restricted to departmental or college, line-authority issues. For more general policy matters relating to faculty concerns which have University-wide ramifications, the Deans' Council and the Faculty Senate constitute the two academic bodies who recommend general academic policy to the University Provost.
