## **Run-Ons**

<p><b>Definition:</b> A <b>run-on sentence</b> occurs when two independent clauses (sentences with subjects and verbs) are joined either without any punctuation or conjunction between them (also known as <b>fused sentences</b>) or with a conjunction with missing punctuation.</p>	<p><b>Examples:</b> Those are nice boots I like your belt too. [Two independent clauses without any punctuation or conjunction] Those are nice boots O</p>
